

# Say hello to Liberty DSL WiFi

Don't let WiFi issues get you down



## Here are step by step instructions to get your Liberty WiFi up and running with a DSL modem.

	<p><b>1</b> Verify your name and address are on the front of the box.</p>		<p><b>6</b> Plug the power cord into the black port that says, "POWER" on the back of your router then plug it into a regular outlet.</p>
	<p><b>2</b> Remove contents in the box. Your box should include: a. Router b. Base with SSID and password c. Power cord d. Ethernet cord e. Modem</p>		<p><b>7</b> Push "ON/OFF" button. It will click down.</p>
	<p><b>3</b> Put router on base</p>		<p><b>8</b> Wait about ten minutes for the firmware to update and your router to become operational.</p>
<p><b>4</b> <b>a.</b> Make sure your modem is working. Watch the video tutorial if you need help setting up your modem, <a href="https://bit.ly/34yl6el">https://bit.ly/34yl6el</a>.</p>	<p><b>b.</b> If your modem is already working, you can skip ahead to 3:30 in the video to learn how to connect your router to your modem.</p>	<p><b>9</b> If you set up a new SSID and password, connect your devices. If you used the same SSID and password as before, you don't need to do anything; your devices should connect automatically!</p>	<p><b>10</b> Get your streaming, gaming, surfing, working, video chatting, or social media-ing on!</p>
	<p><b>5</b> <b>a.</b> Plug one end of the ethernet cord into the white port on the router that says "ETH-WAN."</p>		<p><b>b.</b> Plug the other end of the cord into one of the Ethernet ports. *If you have the grey modem, do not use the EWAN port to connect your router.</p>
